

# Vision Statement – Active Transportation Plan

Develop a comprehensive active transportation network providing safe and comfortable mobility options for all of Ontario's residents, employees, and visitors, thereby enhancing the City's economic vibrancy and promoting a healthy lifestyle for the Ontario community.



#### Vision Statement – East Idaho Avenue

Create multimodal connections between downtown and the East Idaho Avenue commercial area and enhance the **streetscape** of the East Idaho Avenue corridor, thereby **better connecting** Ontario residents and visitors to employment opportunities and enhancing the economic vibrancy of the East Idaho Avenue corridor.



#### Goals – Both Plans

- Goal #1 Mobility
  - Provide a balanced, safe, and efficient multimodal transportation system for all members of the community
- Goal #2 Safety
  - Improve the multimodal transportation system to enhance safety for all users, skill levels, and ages



#### East Idaho Avenue Concept




















# Crossing Projects Prioritization




# Proposed Biking Project Types



# Code Amendments Implementing Ordinances



#### **Objectives**

- Reference new planning documents and street standards
- Increase opportunities for mixed use development
- Enhance pedestrian and bicycle connectivity and experience
- Improve landscaping requirements
- Reduce land and cost associated with parking



#### **Pedestrian Connectivity**

- Provide connections to sidewalks, pathways
- Provide pathways within large parking areas and for large format uses
- Orient new large format uses to streets and intersections



#### Enhanced Landscaping Requirements

- Applies to new commercial, multi-family uses
- Require drought-tolerant plants
- Provide flexibility on non-plant materials
- Enhance parking lot landscaping
- Use mix of plant species
- Improve pedestrian environment



#### Off-Street Parking – reductions for:

- Restaurants and taverns (simpler standards)
- Retail stores and shops
- ► Funeral homes
- Bowling alleys
- Other commercial services
