South Oregon Businesses,

Good news! Concrete work on landscape bulb-outs and ADA ramps for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Avenues will be complete by the end of this week (June 12). The landscaped areas will continue to be coned off until landscaping is complete.

Traffic Control (barricades and closure) will continue through Friday June 12 as final patching is completed around the new concrete bulbouts and ADA ramps.

Traffic control measures will be removed from S Oregon, or at least pushed out of the way, for the next two weeks.

Small areas could be barricaded off if work can be scheduled for the bulb-outs during this timeframe, but no full street closure will happen.

The final effort for the project will require heavy patching on side streets the week of June 29, followed by milling of the existing pavement on S Oregon as well as back along the side streets.

New asphalt paving will follow the milling process.

The milling and paving process can take up to 2 weeks to complete but could be accomplished quicker. We anticipate the patching, milling and paving effort to start June 29 and run through July 10.

Traffic control will roll through in the 2-block system as was used during the landscape bulbout/ADA ramp construction process. As with the original work, this will require a hard road closure of 2 blocks at one time. Sidewalks will remain open.

*Final work on the landscaping of the bulb-outs will occur over the summer, but a final schedule has not yet been developed for this work.
